Chateau Potensac-Chapelle de Potensac- Medoc 2011 \$ 49

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Delicate, red and black fruits, cinnamon powder, spicy black pepper; chocolat and mineral-graphit. Delicious and a bit lighter than most Bordeaux.

Chateau Brulesecaille - Côte de Bourg 2012 \$ 55

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Intense ruby red color. Intense aromas of vanilla, blackberry and spices.
Palate with black fruit and pepper. Rather powerful with still strong tannins.
Medium long aftertaste.

Chateau du Grand Cardinal - Saint-Émilion Grand Cru 2014 \$ 57

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec
Good aroma with black currant and vanilla taste. Round and smooth. Fruity full flavour.
Elegant and structured

Château de Pressac Saint-Émilion (Grand Cru Classé) 2014 \$ 84

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Carmenère
Dark ruby/purple core. Intense nose with finely toasted oak, ripe dark fruit, violet, cassis and blackberry, the palate is dense and concentrated with grainy tannin, layers of ripe dark fruit, fine spiciness and a long fleshy finish. Powerful but with a fine freshness and elegance.

Château Maucaillou Le Haut-Médoc de Maucaillou 2014 \$ 44

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec
Excellent wine which taste like a grand cru. Very dark red, lovely on the palette.
Tannic and earthy.

Château Maucaillou Moulis 2011 \$ 102

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec
Always a reliable pleasure Maucaillou is. Long legs musk on the nose
smooth finish

Château Haut-Surget Lalande-de-Pomerol 2015 \$ 74

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec
Attractive, lifted nose with flavours that are expressive and ripe. The wine is gentle, not an intense/powerful style but offering upfront charm.

Clos Des Menuts Saint-Émilion Grand Cru 2004 \$ 98

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Clear, medium, garnet. Clean in the nose with medium aromatic intensity, aromas of black fruits (blackberry, blueberry), dried fruits (prune), plum, a touch of chocolate and mushroom, smoky, toasty. Dry on the palate, with medium+ acidity, medium tannins, medium body, strong cherry, peppery, smokiness, medium finish. Well balanced, powerful.

Château Croix de Bertinat Révélation Saint-Émilion Grand Cru 2014 \$ 76

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Smooth. Full body. Very light fruit.

Bourgogne

Red

Pommard 1er Cru 'La Refène' 2015 \$ 122

Grapes: Pinot Noir
Young Elegance. Very pleasant, discrete in the nose, with aromas of dark berries, flowers and strawberry. It shows a fruity character on the palate with beautiful flavors of strawberry, raspberry.

Gevrey-Chambertin 2014 Moillard-Grivot \$ 106

Grapes: Pinot Noir
Easy and smooth. Prunes, wild flowers, beetroot on the aroma. Gooseberries, red currants on the palate.

Mercurey Domaine de la Framboisiere \$ 62

Grapes: Pinot Noir
Fruity clean well balanced wine. Light bodied red.

Chassagne-Montrachet Vieilles Vigne 2013 \$ 94

Grapes: Pinot Noir
Clean, clear, bright, medium+ alcohol and complexity. Chalky minerality nose and taste. Velvet feel with nice medium finish. A very good pinot.

White

Pouilly-Fuissé Terroir Domaine Lassarat 2015 \$ 49

Grapes: Chardonnay
Lively - and - Lovely with great floral notes, full bodied, character of delightful joy, freshness with lingering nose and aromas. You never go wrong with this one.

Vin de Loire

Sancerre La Chenaye 2016 Loire France \$ 46

Grapes: Sauvignon Blanc
Mineral rich easy drinking wine from the Loire Valley.

Côte du Rhône

Crozes-Hermitage Rouge \$ 44

Grapes: Shiraz/Sirah
From this renowned terroir in the northern Rhône Valley, the SIRAH grape offers a crisp, supple and fresh wine, exhaling red fruits with a spicy touch. Savory mouthfeel, medium-bodded.

Vin du Pays d'Oc

Red

- Merlot Gallician** \$ 32
Beautiful garnet red color with purple reflections. Black jammy fruit flavors seduced us. On the palate the fruit and spice aromas follow each another, leaving a soft impression of roundness.
- Cabernet Sauvignon Gallician** \$ 32
Aromas of black fruits and pepper. The mouth feel brings plum, cedar and spices.
- Magnus Gallician AOC Costières-de-Nîmes** \$ 39
Deep ruby red with purple hues. Ripe dark cherries, smooth and silky wine.
- Terre des Launes AOC Costières-de-Nîmes** \$ 34
Cherry colored dress fairly steady. Powerful nose, combining aromas of fruits in alcohol, spices and leather. The palate is generous with balsamic notes. Long finish through melted and persistent tannins.
- Pinot Noir Terrasses de Perret Les Vignerons du Pic** \$ 33
Intense ruby red and cherry in color with very refreshing and flattering, gentle pepper hints and milk chocolate. On the palate it is juicy, fruity, supple, very light with soft tannins.

Rosé

- Les Bagatelles Costières-de-Nîmes Rosé Gallician** \$ 32
Excellent wine under the Provençal sun. A little dry and ripe berries on the palate. Rosé with both red fruits, wild flowers and an underlying dryness.

White

- Villa Blanche Chardonnay Calmel & Joseph 2016** \$ 39
Very nice, not too oaky. A mix of Peach and vanilla on the nose. Lots of minerals, the acidity gives a nice sparkle on the tongue. Nice long aftertaste with an oaky finish.
- Chardonnay Gallician** \$ 32
Very beautiful pale golden color with green highlights. a very present nose dominated by aromas of white flowers and honey. The mouth is full and all curvy.
- Sauvignon Gallician** \$ 32
Beautiful clear transparent dress green highlights. Citrus and exotic fruit notes merge. In the mouth it is a journey that invites you to discover aromas of fruit and spices. Good roundness and good vivacity.

Côte de Provence

Rosé

- Clos Beylesse Côtes de Provence Rosé Domaine de l'Abbaye** \$ 69
Grapes: Shiraz/ Sirah, Grenache, Cinsault
Very refreshing and delicate for a hot summer day.
- Carte Noire Côtes de Provence Rosé Saint-Tropez** \$ 44
Grapes: Grenache, Cinsault
Elegant ,strong acidic strawberry ,fruity and dry côte de Provence from Saint- Tropez , fun , vibrant , enjoyable.
- Domaines Ott Clos Mireille Rosé (Coeur de Grain)** \$ 99
Grapes: Shiraz/ Sirah, Grenache, Cinsault
From a beautiful estate close to the sea, this wine has a lightly salty character. That contrasts with the zinging energy and ripeness of the fruit and balanced acidity. Citrus zest and spice complete this harmonious wine.

Australia

- Shays Flat Vineyard Shiraz Tournon** \$ 75
Grapes: Shiraz/ Sirah
Big inky blackberry, with the stems, softens to black cherry with a big mid palate kick of pepper and spice. Soft silky tannins but still quite big. Excellent finish.

Spain

- TW 12 (Twelve) Monastrell Alceño** \$ 44
Grapes: Monastrell
Deep ruby-purple, long and slow tears. Fruity in the nose right after pulling the cork, along with some herbal hints (spearmint). After some breathing the wood comes full blown with some leather and vanilla. Full in the mouth, raspy tannins (but in a good way), good wood, ripe red fruits with a lingering, long finish.

USA

- Château Ste. Michelle Riesling Columbia Valley** \$ 49
Classic apple and brown spice aromas greet the nose. Crisp apple, fruit peach and subtle grapefruit flavors unfold in the glass. Bright, firm acidity balances the fruity, elegant finish.

- Château Ste. Michelle Chardonnay Columbia Valley** \$ 49
Very nice Chardonnay, with a bright golden-yellow color. Nose: juicy, tropical fruit, hay, dried herbs and oak. In the mouth: tropical fruit, melon, mango, papaya, banana a little, yellow apple, some fresh herbs, toasted and buttery notes. Wine gentle, balanced, fresh and juicy, with buttery aftertaste. The finish, long, creamy - fruity, elegant.

- Salvestrin LeBlanc Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc 2016 St. Helena Napa Valley** \$ 69
Vibrantly aromatic this wine jumps from the glass with ripe peach and tropical fruit as a theme. Rich and concentrated on the palate the fruit returns and is framed by a wonderful mouth coating texture with tremendous depth. 100% Sauvignon Blanc

- Duckhorn Vineyards Merlot 2014 Napa Valley USA** \$ 109
Combining lovely structure and alluring appeal, this is a classic expression of Duckhorn Vineyards Merlot. Intense aromas of ripe cherry, plum and black fig rise from the glass, underscored by hints of leather and cedar. Wine Spectator 92

- Duckhorn Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2015 Napa Valley USA** \$ 129
Beginning with a gorgeous nose of boysenberry, cherry, strawberry, cedar, sage and licorice, this lush and lively Cabernet captures the rich diversity of Napa Valley.

- Cakebread Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2015 Napa Valley USA** \$ 149
Grapes: Cabernet sauvignon, merlot, petit verdot, cabernet franc
Pretty aromas of ripe boysenberry, dark cherry and cassis, coupled with scents of sweet oak and herbal spice, introduce plush, deeply concentrated, black fruit flavors bolstered by bright acidity and well-structured tannins.

- Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 2015 Napa Valley USA** \$ 125
The ripeness of the vintage is readily apparent as pineapple and stone fruit burst from the glass during the first pour. Fresh melon, along with cinnamon, nutmeg and myriad baking spices follow suit as the wine begins to warm and its aromatic opulence comes into focus.

- Chateau Montelena Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 Napa Valley USA** \$ 125
Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot
On the nose this wine exhibits blackberry jam, vanilla, and allspice leap out of the glass yet gracefully yield to notes of dried plum and perfume with some patience. Deceptively soft up front, with fresh strawberry and raspberry immediately apparent.

Italy

Red

Chianti Classico Campomaggio Tuscany \$ 35

Grapes: Sangiovese
Very dry, mushroom, acidity noticeable, cherries, full bodied.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano Vigna Scianello 2010 La Ciarliana \$ 75

Grapes: Sangiovese
Delicious montepulciano with depth and intensity. Very deep aromas of cherries tobacco and licorice with hints of spices.

Brunello di Montalcino 2012 Molino Della Suga \$ 134

Grapes: Sangiovese
This is a tiny corner of paradise! It shows some youth with a tiny bit of bricking on the edge of beautiful garnet. The nose is a bit surprising with dried raspberry, potpourri and faint baking spices. The flavor adds notes of blackberry & black cherry. Wrap that up in that long elegant body with a lingering finish!

Brunello di Montalcino 2012 Val di Suga \$ 134

Grapes: Sangiovese
The 2012 vintage is rich & concentrated, with ripe fruit & freshness, well-structured & long finish. The nose is conflicting with cherries, plums and flowers....yes flowers mixed with chocolate. Palate with medium high tannins and acidity which has lasting mouthwatering effects. The red berries flavors add to this a lovely feeling of jammy texture.

Salento Rosso Verso \$ 48

Grapes: Primitivo, Negroamaro, Malvasia Nera
Meaty, lots of body with a great, lightly velvety mouth feel. Flavor packed but not over the top. Black cherry and coffee balanced nicely by supple tannins. Almost a little bitter on the finish, but in a nice way. Superb and a great

Valpolicella Classico Superiore Le Calendre \$ 56

Grapes: Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara, Corvinone
Juicy and elegant with aromas of small red fruit and a touch of oak

Eremo San Quirico Nativ \$ 77

Grapes: Aglianico
Incredible dark and dense fruit with a raw tobacco and wet leather smell, nuances of road tar and creamy oak follow. Overall wow!

White

Pinot Grigio La di Motte Venezia \$ 34

Fruity and pleasant pale colored Pinot Grigio from Venezia, offering a quite discrete nose of unripe peach, apple and agrume flavors like citrus. The palate starts off crisp but evolves towards a more rounded and oily mouthfeel,

Sparkling wine & Champagne

Prosecco Botter \$ 35

Medium lemon colour. Pear drop nose, very typical Prosecco. Some lemon and apples. Light on the palate with some biscuits. Short clean finish.
